

Train-the-Trainer (T3) Interprofessional Faculty Development Program (T3-IFDP)*



WHAT IS THE T3-IFDP?

The T3-IFDP is a two-part faculty development program for health professional faculty and clinicians working with interprofessional (IP) and collaborative practice (IPCP) initiatives who want to enhance their leadership skills and capabilities to lead IP efforts in their organizations. Participants attend a 3.5-day, in-person training (at one of three national sites) followed by four, one-hour quarterly coaching webinars.

WHAT TO EXPECT WITH THE T3-IFDP?

- Participants sign up with at least a 3-person, interprofessional team.
- Pre-work readings, reflections and assignments to strengthen your project idea and knowledge of IPE.
- Participate in a 3.5-day experiential, in-person training followed by 4, one-hour quarterly coaching webinars.
- Learn content, skills, and strategies for implementing and evaluating IPE and IPCP, leading change within an organization, and facilitating and coaching teams of IP learners (students, trainees, educators, clinicians).
- Receive 1:1 coaching from T3 facilitators by phone.
- CE credits available.

- Cost: \$5985 for a team of three; \$7980 for a team of four; and \$9975 for a team of five (includes program fees, meals, CE credits and certificate of completion).
- Scholarships available for clinical teams serving rural and medically underserved populations.
- Certificates of Completion awarded at the end of the T3-IFDP.

SAMPLE TEAM PROJECTS INCLUDE

- Build a national graduate certificate program for palliative care.
- Establish an IP center of healthcare excellence in simulation studies.
- Build a cadre of IP faculty/clinicians to meet critical and unmet health needs in a rural, medically underserved areas.
